To the untrained eye a heap of rusting pipes seems to have little in common with a bomb blast. But scientists (and science teachers) see both as examples of an oxidation reduction reaction, or redox reaction for short. Simply stated, this reaction refers to the process by which electrons transfer from one atom, which is oxidized, to another atom, which is reduced.
