How to Make Paper Beads - Easy Peasy and Fun

Measure and cut a piece of decorative paper that is 12 inches long by 10 ½ inches wide. Note that the width determines how many beads you will be able to create: You will get about 2 beads per inch. So, the 12"x10 ½" piece of paper will yield 20 beads

(the extra $\frac{1}{2}$ is added in just to be safe). If you want more beads, make your paper wider.

paper bead, colored side facing out. Start by placing a toothpick across the base of a paper shape and rolling the paper around the toothpick a few times. Add some glue to the remaining paper and roll it tightly around the toothpick into a bead.

1) Place paper bead on a tooth pick and roll it over the embossing ink pad. How to make your own paper beads: 1) Cut your paper so that you have a wide end leading to a pointy end. You will end up with long, triangular strips. The wider you cut, the bigger the bead.

Paper Beads | The Craft Train

All along one edge of your paper, make a mark at every inch. On the opposite edge, make the first mark at 1/2 inch and then every 1" from then on (i.e. at 1 1/2", 2 1/2", 3 1/2", etc.) This side marks the center of the bead which will measure half of the length of the whole bead.

-Organize a work space with the 8 diagonal paper strips, several toothpicks, a glue stick and some clear nail polish. -Take a toothpick and one paper strip. Roll the WIDE end of the paper strip completely around the toothpick ONE rotation. Next, take the glue stick and quickly cover the remaining paper surface with glue.

Making the beads: The first part of making the beads is measuring, drawing, and cutting your sheet of paper into skinny wedge shapes that are three

centimeters thick on the fat end, and taper to a point. 1. Start by placing your paper pattern-side down and in “portrait” position (taller than wide).
